

## Finding the right tool



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**I had been striving to find a way of improving my treatment outcomes for some time. With experience in natural fertility, nutrition and hair mineral analysis, I was looking for the right tool to compliment my skills. I wanted to help the clients who needed more than natural medicines.**

Reducing the cost of successful treatment was a priority. I explored many options, including various forms of vibrational technology. Some were too complicated for my liking. I needed a practical tool. Patient comfort was also important, including how the client felt during a treatment.

A naturopath colleague of mine introduced me to the SCENAR machine. I took her offer and received a SCENAR treatment for a difficult skin condition of my own. After six

weeks the problem disappeared, never to return.

I was impressed with the simplicity of my treatment. The SCENAR machines are hand held and portable. I liked it because it was interactive, yet quite sophisticated. The practitioner does not require a high level of skill to use the equipment. It tells the user when the treatment has finished.

SCENAR utilises a biofeedback mechanism. It has diagnostic aspect, with the ability to take readings of points that lay either side of the spine and some on the face. Areas of pain can also be treated. Measurements of the site of contact are taken via an electrode on the face of the machine. A small electronic pulse is then fed back to the site. The machine itself determines the size of the dose.

SCENAR is particularly useful for patients with pain, however I use it for many

other symptoms such as infections, childhood complaints, gastritis, migraines and frozen shoulder. There are cases of incomplete healing after trauma that would benefit from a treatment. General wellbeing and energy may also be achieved with this treatment. Patients who are unable to take medicines for one reason or another also respond well to SCENAR.

One thing I now realise is that many of my patients had pain that they never told me about. I didn't know that they were seeing other practitioners to manage their pain. Now I am able to help my patients with many more symptoms than before.
